The above named patient is currently under our care for pregnancy. In general, dental procedures may be performed during the prenatal period. Procedures that can be safely delayed without risk to the patient should be postponed until after delivery.

Local anesthetics are safe during pregnancy (please avoid epinephrine), as well as penicillins, cephalosporins, and erythromycins. If discomfort is expected Tylenol III or Darvocet may be prescribed. Of course, patient allergies should be considered.

Please avoid antibiotics in the Tetracycline class, such as Doxycycline, and Quinolones, such as Floxin and Cipro.

Additionally, if dental X rays are necessary, please provide abdominal shielding.
